**Job Title:** Senior AV Systems Engineer

**Position Summary:** The Senior AV Engineer plays a critical role in delivering advanced AV solutions through expert design, configuration, and implementation. Supporting pre- and post-sales activities, this position bridges technical knowledge with client engagement, ensuring seamless delivery of AV systems. Responsibilities span from system architecture and project management to on-site troubleshooting, collaborating with clients and cross-functional teams for exceptional outcomes.

## Pre-Sales Design and Planning:

- Pre-Sales and Design Support
- Translate client needs into functional system designs and block diagrams.
- Assist with technical design reviews and provide labor/material estimates for proposals.
- Generate architectural drawings, acoustical models, and documentation as required.

### **Project Execution & Engineering:**

- Configure, program, and test AV systems
- Troubleshoot technical issues and ensure system functionality meets client requirements.
- Collaborate with Lead Technicians and Project Managers to ensure timely project completion.
- Provide on-site customer training and system handoff.

Coordinate with vendors, engineers, and programmers to resolve issues.

Support the Help Desk on escalated service calls.

Travel regionally or nationally as required for client projects.

- Ability to obtain formal approved clearances (Government or system specific) required.
